Attention is invited to the reference cited, wherein a copy of your RTI application dated 01.10.2023 regarding the Mullaperiyar or/and Idukki Reservoirs or /and Reservoirs downstream under section 6 and 7(1) of RTI Act 2005 was forwarded to this office.

With reference to your queries, the information pertaining to Mullaperiyar Dam is as follows:

1. Mullaperiyar Reservoir.
2. Many studies have been conducted by various authorities regarding the Mullaperiyar Dam. Many reports are large in size. You have not specified the name of the report. Many reports can be shared only after the finalisation of the Data Dissemination Policy, which is under way.
3. Details not available in this office.
4. Yes. Central Water Commission in 2017 has prepared the flood inundation maps highlighting the flooding patterns of the region from Mullaperiyar Dam

to Arabian Sea due to three conditions such as Dam failure by over topping, a non-flood dam failure caused by internal erosion and a large controlled release flood through the spillway. Government of Kerala has requested to revise the dam break study by incorporating the maximum flood level data observed in 2018 and had supplied the essential details requested for the same. The updated analysis is under progressing in Central Water Commission.

5.Studies incorporating the climatic changes in recent years or future are under consideration.

6.Activity not related to this office.
